

ORDINANCE NO. 106

AN ORDINANCE OF WHITE TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY,  
COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA,  
REGULATING FIRES

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of White, a Township of the Second Class in the County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania do hereby enact and ordain as follows:

1. Any and all burning is to be conducted only on Tuesday and Saturday from 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM.
2. All fires must be within an appropriate container encompassing the fire.
3. All fires must be more than ten (10) feet from any structure or property line.
4. Fires must be attended at all times.
5. Not permitted at any time is the burning of diapers, garbage, plastics, leaves, brush, grass clippings, hedges or any type of trash or rubbish not specified previously. Only cardboard or paper products are acceptable for burning.
6. Fires must be completely extinguished by the expiration of time allowed for burning.
7. Cooking on gas, charcoal grills, or outdoor cooking facilities is permitted.
8. Fires other than those previously specified must have a burning permit issued by the Township Secretary and approved by a Township Supervisor.

9. Penalties:

- (A) First Offense: Warning
- (B) Second Offense: Within two (2) years, \$50.00 fine.
- (C) Third Offense: Within two (2) years, \$500.00 fine.

10. In case of fire emergency hazard of extremely dry weather conditions, the Board of Supervisors is authorized to ban all fires within the Township for the duration of the emergency. When such a ban takes effect by action of the Board of Supervisors, appropriate means shall be taken, to publicize the ban in local media.
