

ORDINANCE NO. 117

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE,
COUNTY OF BEAVER, THE COMMONWEALTH OF
PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING A CURFEW FOR
CERTAIN MINORS AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF.

The Supervisors of White Township, a Township of the Second Class in Beaver County, Pennsylvania, do hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: From and after the enactment of this Ordinance, it shall be unlawful for any minor under eighteen (18) years of age to be in any public place or on any public street, road, alley, or sidewalk within the Township of White from the hours of 11:00 PM until 6:00 AM, Eastern Standard Time or Daylight Savings Time whichever is in effect in the community. The hour of 11:00 PM shall be known as the curfew time in said Township, unless said minor is accompanied by a responsible person of good repute over twenty-one (21) years of age, or is in the performance of an errand or duty directed by his or her parent, guardian, or legal custodian, or whose legal recognized employment makes it necessary for such child to be in or upon said public street, road, alley, or sidewalk or other public place after the hour of 11:00 PM in which case such child shall carry a certified card of employment signed by the Secretary of the Board of White Township Supervisors.

SECTION 2: It shall also be unlawful for any parent, guardian, or other person having legal care or custody of a minor under the age of eighteen (18) years to allow any of their minor children, or minors over which they have custody, to be in any public place, street, road, alley, or sidewalk within the Township between the hours of 11:00 PM and 6:00 AM, except as specified in Section 1 of this Ordinance, or unless reasonable necessity can be shown therefor.


SECTION 3: This Curfew Ordinance shall not apply so long as a minor is in the process of traveling immediately from a public, school, or church function to his home, but shall apply if said minor shall fail to immediately go home from said public, school, or church function.

SECTION 4: If any minor shall violate the terms of this Ordinance and shall be found in a public place as set forth in previous Sections, during the time herein specified as curfew time, said minor shall be taken into custody by the Township Police and delivered to his or her parent, guardian or person having legal custody of said minor. The police shall keep a record thereof in a book to be kept for that purpose. Said parent, guardian or person having legal custody of said minor so offending shall, upon conviction thereof, pay a fine of Twenty-five (\$25.00) Dollars for the first offense and costs, the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each additional violation and costs. Upon default of any fine levied under this Ordinance, a delinquency petition will be filed with Juvenile Division of the Courts of Beaver County pursuant to the Juvenile Act.


SECTION 5: All ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed insofar as they are inconsistent with the terms of this ordinance.


