

ORDINANCE NO. 120

AN ORDINANCE OF WHITE TOWNSHIP, BEAVER COUNTY,
PENNSYLVANIA, PROVIDING FOR A CERTAIN SPEED
LIMIT AND OTHERWISE REGULATING TRAFFIC ON
PART OF STATE ROUTE NO. 588 WITHIN THE TOWN-
SHIP AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS
THEREOF.

PURSUANT to the Authority contained in the Motor Vehicle Code and the Second Class Township Code, and pursuant to permission received from the Department of Highways of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, the Board of Supervisors of the Township of White, County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, does hereby enact and Ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: The White Township Board of Supervisors does hereby establish a Speed Limit of Forty (40) Miles per Hour on that part of State Route No. 588 within the Township of White extending from Station 0+39 and 53+15 and that it shall be unlawful for any person to operate or drive a motor vehicle on said portion of said Route 588 at a Speed in excess of the said Limit of Forty (40) Miles per Hour.

SECTION 2: That the officials of the Township shall cause to be erected proper signs designating the posted Speed Limit of Forty (40) Miles per Hour on State Route No. 588 between Stations 0+39 and 53+15.

SECTION 3: That it shall be unlawful for any person to operate a motor vehicle on State Route No. 588 within the Township of White so as to pass another motor vehicle proceeding in the same direction at any point where a solid white center line has been marked on said highway.


SECTION 4: That there is hereby created such no-passing zones on State Route No. 588 as shall be from time to time designated by Resolution of the Board of Supervisors of the Township of White and said no-passing zones shall be marked by duly posted signs reading "NO PASSING" and shall be further marked by a solid white line appearing in the center of said highway.

SECTION 5: Any violations of this Ordinance shall be enforced in the manner set forth in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania Motor Vehicle Code.


SECTION 6: All Ordinances or parts of prior Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.
