

ORDINANCE NO. 82

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14, PROHIBITING THE DISCHARGE OF ANY GUN, FLOBERT RIFLE, AIR GUN, SPRING GUN, OR ANY IMPLEMENT WHICH IMPELS OR FORCES A METAL PELLET OF ANY KIND; BOW AND ARROW; SLING SHOTS; EXCEPT IN NECESSARY DEFENSE OF PERSON OR PROPERTY AND FURTHER PROHIBITING THE SETTING UP OF TARGET RANGES WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

The Board Of Supervisors of the Township of White hereby enact and ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: No persons shall, except in necessary defense of person or property, fire or discharge any Gun, Flobert Rifle, Air Gun, Spring Gun, or any implement which impels or forces a metal pellet of any kind; Bow and Arrow; Sling Shots; and that no person shall set up target ranges within the Township of White.

SECTION 2: Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof before any District Justice or Court of Common Pleas of Beaver County, be guilty of a summary offense as defined in the Pennsylvania Revised Code (Criminal Law) and shall be sentenced under the provisions relevant thereto.

SECTION 3: All Ordinances or parts of prior Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent that they are inconsistent with this Ordinance.
