

ORDINANCE NO. 97

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, BEAVER COUNTY, AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 61, EMPOWERING THE TOWNSHIP TO PROHIBIT AND REMOVE AND TO REQUIRE THE REMOVAL OF SUCH NUISANCE BY THE OWNER AND/OR OCCUPIER OF SUCH GROUNDS, AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION.

THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED and ORDAINED by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of White, Beaver County, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by authority of the same, as follows:

The provisions of Section IX, of Ordinance No. 61, is hereby amended to read as follows:

IX Whoever violates or fails to comply with any provision of the Ordinance shall be fined a minimum of \$200 and maximum of \$600.00. A separate offense shall be deemed committed each day during or on which a violation or non compliance occurs or continues after the expiration of the time set forth in the notice to abate or remove the nuisance. The fine and costs herein provided shall be in addition to the cost of removal permitted to be recovered by the terms and provision of Pamphlet Law No. 103, Article VII, Section 702, Clause XIII, of May 1, 1993, as amended.

Any provision of Ordinance No. 61, inconsistent with the above amendment is hereby amended as set forth above. All other provisions of Ordinance No. 61, not inconsistent herewith are to remain in full force and effect.
