

MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS WHITE TOWNSHIP April 4, 2018

On Wednesday, April 4, 2018 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13th Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio and began with a moment of silence and The Pledge of Allegiance.

This Meeting was advertised in the *Beaver County Times* on January 17, 2018 in accordance with the Sunshine Law, Section 709.

Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to accept the minutes of the March 7, 2018 Regular Meeting. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.

Reports:

Wage Tax: Supervisor DeMeio read that \$8,273.79 was collected in March.

Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee: R.E. \$32,263.39 or F.P.F. \$3,185.00 collected in March.

Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary: A.P. = \$9,096.99; P.R. = \$2,576.78

Police: Chief Stanislawski read that there were 51 calls in March, resulting in 2 arrests (theft & public intoxication).

Fire Department: Supervisor Evans read there was 1 call in March: 3/30 Mutual aid to West Mayfield.

Road Crew: Work orders given to the road crew: 3/8: Twp. property near 2001 Clayton Rd. has a dead tree that needs to be removed. Supervisor Evans said he'll take care of it, but doesn't know when.

Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to accept the reports as read. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.

Correspondence:

1. 3/13: Herrmann & Loll, CPA gave a written estimate to do the FD audit: \$1,500.00. After some discussion, it was decided to table this subject until next month's meeting.

Unfinished Business:

1. In regards to the 2 vacant Elected Auditor positions: Lou Adrian of the Vacancy Board has not appointed anyone. After some discussion, it was decided to table this subject until next month's meeting.

2. On 3/19/18 & 3/23/18 a request for sealed bids for the Twp.'s 1996 Dodge Ram was advertised in the *Beaver County Times*, with the bids being opened during tonight's meeting. The 3 sealed bids were received from:

- Craig Bischoff of Beaver Falls for \$2,425.00

- Jon Miller of East Palestine for \$4,000.00

- K. Gaudino of Freedom for \$456.00

Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to award the bid to Jon Miller for \$4,000.00. Supervisor Evans seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.

3. A complaint was filed with the DEP about stormwater flooding at 114 Wilson Ave. in West Mayfield. A worksite meeting with White Twp. (represented by our Engineer, Solicitor and one Supervisor) along with two West Mayfield representatives took place on 3/23/18. The recommended action from the Engineer:

“The stormwater outfall should have adequate outfall protection per PaDEP requirements. This will address the erosion issue that was observed along the southern edge of the property. LSSE recommends installing R-5 riprap per the attached detail.

Wilson Drive would need to be regraded to redirect the water away from Mr. Mathey’s property and into the drainage swale that the outfall pipe discharges into currently. However, since Wilson Drive is owned and maintained by West Mayfield Borough this work would need to be coordinated through them to complete.”

4. After some discussion about the sinkhole on 23rd/24th Ave.; ***Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to start this project, pending weather conditions, to be completed by end of April, with the exception of black top. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.***

New Business:

1. None.

1. The Twp.’s audit is scheduled for Friday 4/6.
