

**MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS  
WHITE TOWNSHIP  
April 3, 2019**

On Wednesday, April 3, 2019 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13<sup>th</sup> Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio and began with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

This Meeting was advertised in the *Beaver County Times* on January 2, 2019 in accordance with the Sunshine Law, Section 709.

***Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to approve the minutes of the March 6, 2019 Regular Meeting. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.***

**Reports:**

**Earned Income Tax:** Supervisor DeMeio read that \$8,830.21 was collected in March.

**Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee:** R.E. \$46,070.61 / F.P.F. \$2,430.00 collected in March.

**Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary:** A.P. = \$34,737.26; P.R. = \$8,506.14

**Police:** Officer Bathgate read that there were 54 calls in March, resulting in 4 citations and 3 arrests (Bad checks; Animal neglect; Cruelty to animals).

**Code Enforcement:** 2 letters have been sent by the Twp. office in March.

**Fire Department:** Supervisor Evans read that there were 3 calls for service in March. 3/3: MVA on Clayton Rd; 3/19: CO alarm in Colonial Oaks; 3/22: Landing Zone Assist in West Mayfield.

***Supervisor Beatty made a motion requesting the Fire Report include how many firefighters respond to, as well as their time spent at each call. Supervisor DeMeio seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – ABSTAIN. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.***

**Road Crew:** Tom Orłowski said they've started fixing some of the alleyways. They started with the one between Burgess & Orchard, using limestone. Then did 24<sup>th</sup> in Mt. Washington, using a combination of limestone & slag. Also did the alley behind 13<sup>th</sup> Ave. off of Clayton, using only slag. They will monitor each alley in order to see which material(s) work(s) best. He talked to PENNDOT and found out their Braun Rd. location has closed and their central location is in Industry, but they did fix some of the potholes on Clayton and they're helping with the removal of the concrete pad in front of the Twp. building. He said PENNDOT is offering the Twp. 3 options regarding Clayton Rd.: 1) Completely take over responsibility of the roadway; 2) Take over responsibility for part of the roadway; 3) Enter into a joint mutual agreement in order to share responsibilities of the roadway.

***Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to accept the reports as read. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.***

**Correspondence:**

1. Email received on 3/27 from LSSE saying the grants are open for the 12<sup>th</sup> Ave. bridge project. The first step in the process is passing Resolution No. 3 of 2019 – Requesting the grant. The total project is cost is \$523,400.00. Funds requested in grant form is \$402,600.00. White Township's budgeted fund contribution is \$120,800.00.

***Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to pass Resolution No. 3 of 2019. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.***

1. Contract from 3/27 from J. Young Refuse for garbage/recyclable service 5/1/19 – 4/30/22 @ \$41.50/QTR.

### **Public Forum:**

1. Tami Dekorte of 23<sup>rd</sup> Ave. requested that the Twp. get involved with a dispute she's having with one of her neighbors over trees on his property. Supervisor DeMeio and Attorney Bible explained the Twp. cannot get involved private property civil disputes.

2. Maralane Waddingham of 18<sup>th</sup> Ave. would like to have a pipe installed under her driveway in the R-O-W. Once she signs a waiver and buys the pipe the Twp. will install it.

3. Reon Nesmith of 23<sup>rd</sup> St. wants the paper alley behind his house opened. Attorney Bible said the Twp. can abandon it and 7.5' can become part of Nesmith's property. Supervisor DeMeio said she's not in favor of opening the paper alley. Nesmith said there's now a house where there wasn't before and it's necessary it be opened. Supervisor Evans said another option is allowing Nesmith access (giving him a R-O-W) to put his own private driveway in a portion of the paper alley. Nesmith said his neighbors will need to agree to that solution.
