

# MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS WHITE TOWNSHIP February 6, 2019

On Wednesday, February 6, 2019 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13<sup>th</sup> Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio and began with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

This Meeting was advertised in the *Beaver County Times* on January 2, 2019 in accordance with the Sunshine Law, Section 709.

***Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to approve the minutes of the January 7, 2019 Organizational Meeting and Regular Meeting. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.***

## **Reports:**

**Earned Income Tax:** Supervisor DeMeio read that \$4,252.55 was collected in January.

**Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee:** R.E. \$0.00 / F.P.F. \$0.00 collected in January. Filed \$10,765.10 of unpaid 2018 Real Estate Taxes at the courthouse (\$11,303.36 with the penalties.)

**Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary:** A.P. = \$51,632.38; P.R. = \$8,588.14

**Police:** Officer Bathgate read that there were 51 calls in January, resulting in 3 citations and 1 warning.

**Code Enforcement:** 1 notice for garbage was sent out in January.

**Fire Department:** Ray Evans Sr., of the WTVFD provided the WTVFD 2018 expenditure report. It is available for public inspection.

**Road Crew:** Tom Orłowski said they've had 11 call-outs for snow/ice since last month's meeting. They're managing the ice problem on Cottage by using the backhoe to scrape it as needed. The West Mayfield joint road repair agreement is out, with no further details given. He reportedly approached PENNDOT about the lack of snow removal/salting on Clayton Rd. and was told out of 51 main roads in the county, Clayton Rd. is their 51<sup>st</sup> priority.

## **Correspondence:**

1. John Young of J. Young's Refuse called 1/9/19 to say they're no longer collecting glass as part of the recyclables effective the end of this quarter. It's due to the glass breaking when compacted & it contaminates the rest of the recyclables. Brady's Run & Valley Waste are no longer collecting it for the same reason. He'll send the residents a notice with the next bill.

2. John Balsler of MDIA is resigning as UCC Inspector effective 1/28/19. Clyde Volk will replace him.

3. Email received 1/16/19 from PENNDOT requesting the removal of the concrete pad in front of the Twp. building. Supervisor DeMeio met with Michele Yeager, Assistant Highway Maintenance Manager for PENNDOT who said this can be completed once the weather improves and they'll assist the Twp. road crew with flaggers for traffic control on Clayton Rd. during the removal. Yeager suggested that the PTPD monitor Clayton Rd. for speeders. She also talked of installing flashing light on Clayton to warn drivers of the sharp curve.

4. Letter received 1/30/19 from BCHS: Introducing Celina Kelly as the new full-time Animal Control Officer.

1. Lou Adrian submitted a letter of resignation from his elected position as Twp. Tax Collector, taking effect 2/28/19.

2. *Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to pass Resolution No. 2 of 2019 – Naming Nancy Munroe as Twp. Tax Collector for the remainder of 2019. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.*

### **Good & Welfare of the Township:**

1. The Liquid Fuel Audit of 2017 began on 1/30/19 & finished on 2/1/19. There were no findings. A written report will be available for public inspection in a few months.

### **Public Forum:**

1. No one signed up to speak. However, Lou Adrian said he's been the Twp. Tax Collector for 13 years, prior to that he was the White Twp. Chief of Police for 20 years, and prior to that he was a White Twp. Supervisor for 10 years, so he's had a good run.
