WHITE TOWNSHIP
January 6, 2020**

On Monday, January 6, 2020 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13th Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio.

Reports:

Earned Income Tax: Supervisor DeMeio read that \$7,489.38 was collected in December 2019.

Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee: Nancy Munroe read \$2,821.67 was collected in Real Estate and \$110.00 was collected in Fire Protection Fees in December 2019.

Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary: A.P. = \$22,467.57; P.R. = \$8,084.22

Police: Assistant Chief Bathgate read there were 37 calls for service in December, resulting in three traffic citations.

Code Enforcement: No letters were sent in December 2019 from the Twp. office.

Fire Department: Supervisor Evans read there were 3 calls for service in December 2019. 12/12: Wires down/flood in West Mayfield (2 Fire Fighters for 1.5 hrs.); 12/26: Structure fire in West Mayfield (4 Fire Fighters for 2 hrs.); 12/27: Motor vehicle accident in West Mayfield (5 Fire Fighters for 0 hrs. as the call was cancelled).

Road Crew: Tom Orłowski said they've had 3 call outs for snow since the last meeting. They've worked on the brakes and rotators on the dump truck; the bearing on the pickup's salt spreader which was covered under warranty; fixed wires on the backhoe's starter. They've also been patching potholes.
