

**MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS  
WHITE TOWNSHIP  
March 6, 2019**

On Wednesday, March 6, 2019 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13<sup>th</sup> Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio and began with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

This Meeting was advertised in the *Beaver County Times* on January 2, 2019 in accordance with the Sunshine Law, Section 709.

*Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to approve the minutes of the February 6, 2019 Regular Meeting. Supervisor Evans seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Motion carried.*

**Reports:**

**Earned Income Tax:** Supervisor DeMeio read that \$18,401.83 was collected in February.

**Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee:** R.E. \$0.00 / F.P.F. \$123.00 collected in February.

**Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary:** A.P. = \$16,162.31; P.R. = \$9,749.21

**Police:** Officer Bathgate read that there were 59 calls in February, resulting in 1 citation and 2 arrests (criminal mischief & possession of a small amount).

**Code Enforcement:** No letters have been sent by the Twp. office.

**Fire Department:** Supervisor Evans read that there were 3 calls for service in January – February. 1/19: MVA on Clayton Hill; 2/17: Lock out assistance on 26<sup>th</sup> St; 2/24: Tree/wires down on Steffin Hill.

**Road Crew:** Tom Orłowski said they've had 6 call-outs for snow/ice since last month's meeting. They've used approximately 1 dump truck load of salt on Clayton Rd. at the request of PENNDOT & PTPD which will be reimbursed by PENNDOT. They are patching potholes as needed and have used 7 bucket loads of coldpatch. Amerikohl Aggregates of Wampum has limestone for \$12.00/ton pickup or \$16.00/ton delivered. At least 3 truckloads will be needed to begin repairs on alleyways, which he'd like to start in about a month.

*Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to accept the reports as read. Supervisor Evans seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Motion carried.*

**Correspondence:**

1. Letter dated 2/21 from John Young of J. Young's Refuse regarding extending the Twp.'s current contract, (which is set to expire 4/30/19) for another 3 years at the current rate of \$41.50/quarter.

**Unfinished Business:**

1. Participation for the state salt contract is due 3/15. White Twp. has purchased 224.28 tons so far this winter & has met the minimum obligation for both the state & county.

*Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to enter the bid of 300 tons for the state only. Supervisor Evans seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Motion carried.*

**Good & Welfare of the Township:**

1. The Twp.'s 2019 Liquid Fuel Allocation was direct deposited on 3/1 in the amount of \$51,659.02.

1. Dan Swartz of 27<sup>th</sup> St. wanted to thank the road crew for doing such a great job with the roads for it being their first winter on the job.
