

**MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS
WHITE TOWNSHIP
May 1, 2019**

On Wednesday, May 1, 2019 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13th Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio and began with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Reports:

Earned Income Tax: Supervisor DeMeio read that \$5,716.62 was collected in April.

Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee: R.E. \$24,204.45 / F.P.F. \$2,560.00 collected in April.

Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary: A.P. = \$35,759.73; P.R. = \$15,932.56

Police: Chief Stanislawski read that there were 23 calls in April, resulting in 4 citations and 2 arrests (Public drunkenness; Inoperative vehicle ordinance).

Code Enforcement: 3 letters have been sent by the Twp. office in April (2 vehicles, 1 garbage all due 5/1/19).

Fire Department: Supervisor Evans read that there were 2 calls for service in April. 4/13: Fire Alarm Assist in West Mayfield (4 Fire Fighters for 1 hr.); 4/26: Tree/Wires down on Steffin Hill (1 Fire Fighter for .25 hr.).

Road Crew: Tom Orłowski said he had a meeting with PENNDOT and they're still interested in meeting with the Twp. Supervisors to discuss an agility agreement for Clayton Rd. The Supervisors said they're open to meeting with PENNDOT. Dan Fritzley presented riding mower prices from Town-Country.

1. Reon Nesmith of 23rd St. asked when 12th Ave. in Mt. Washington will be paved. Supervisor DeMeio said she figured it'd be done in conjunction with the 12th Ave. bridge repair. He'd like to see the paving of 12th Ave. in Mt. Washington become a priority for the BOS.
2. Donna Nesmith of 22nd St. said White Twp.'s ditch by her home is not accepting water and she's getting water in her basement. She'd like the Twp. to do something about it. The road crew will go there tomorrow, 5/2 to take care of it. If it's a bigger job they'll have to seek the Supervisor's approval before repairs can be made.
