

**MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS
WHITE TOWNSHIP
October 2, 2019**

On Wednesday, October 2, 2019 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13th Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor DeMeio and began with a moment of silence followed by the Pledge of Allegiance.

Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to approve the minutes of the September 4, 2019 Regular Meeting + September 18, 2019 Special Meeting. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.

Reports:

Earned Income Tax: Supervisor DeMeio read that \$7,230.70 was collected in September.

Real Estate Tax & Fire Protection Fee: R.E. \$765.64 / F.P.F. \$67.00 was collected in September.

Accounts Payable & Payroll Summary: A.P. = \$32,127.42; P.R. = \$8,244.04

Police: Officer Thompson read there were 43 calls for service in September, resulting in 1 arrest (theft by unlawful taking) & 7 citations being issued. He also said they're still doing routine patrols of Clayton Rd.

Code Enforcement: 2 letters were sent in September from the Twp. office, both for grass/weeds.

Fire Department: Supervisor Evans said there were no calls for service in September.

Road Crew: Tom Orłowski said they got a good report on the Twp. pickup truck, citing Ron Lewis Ford did not find any problems. He & Dan have been performing routine maintenance on the salt spreaders and said that they're working fine. He reports that PennDOT will start on Steffin Hill at the beginning of 2020.

Correspondence:

1. Notification from PennDOT that the Twp.'s ESTIMATED Liquid Fuels allocation for 2020 is \$49,272.96. That is less than the amount received in 2019 of \$51,659.02.

Unfinished Business:

1. Solicitor Bible said the Beaver Falls public meeting he attended to ask them for a financial contribution in order to repair the 12th Ave. bridge went well. He said their Council was open to the idea but questioned how big of an emergency is this situation. Bible agreed that even though the bridge won't collapse next month, there is a structural weakness, which we are aware of, that cannot be ignored. Beaver Falls asked for a formal, written proposal from White Twp.

New Business:

1. Wyatt Rager who owns 2 parcels both addressed as 2200 Clayton Rd. (but have different parcel numbers) wants to subdivide the properties, changing only the lot sizes. The Twp. does not have a planning commission, nor an application, nor a fee schedule therefore, the Board can allow Rager to start the process & once the Planning Commission of Beaver County reviews it & addresses any concerns, then the Board can approve his subdivision.

Supervisor DeMeio made a motion to allow Rager to start the subdivision process. Supervisor Beatty seconded. Supervisor DeMeio – YES. Supervisor Evans – YES. Supervisor Beatty – YES. Motion carried.

1. Safely dispose of household chemicals on Saturday, 10/12 at Brady’s Run Park Recycling Center from 9am-1pm. \$3/gallon cash only. And starting on 10/21 they’ll have new hours: Mon. & Tues. 8:30am-3:30pm; Wed. noon – 5:00pm; Thurs. 8:30am – 3:30pm; Fri. CLOSED; Every 3rd Sat. 8:30am – noon.
