

ORDINANCE NO. 52

AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE, BEAVER COUNTY, AUTHORIZING THE PAVING AND CURBING OF VARIOUS AVENUES AND STREETS DESIGNATED THEREIN, SITUATE WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP AND PROVIDING FOR THE ASSESSMENT OF COSTS OF SAID PAVING AND CURBING AGAINST THE ABUTTING PROPERTY OWNERS

The Board of Supervisors of the Township of White, a Township of the Second Class, Beaver County, hereby ordains as follows:

Section 1: The Board of Township Supervisors is hereby authorized to pave and curb the following avenues and streets situate within the Township, to-wit: Eleventh Avenue; Twelfth Avenue; Thirteenth Avenue; Nineteenth Avenue; Twenty-first Avenue; Twenty-second Avenue; Twenty-third Avenue; Twenty-fourth Avenue; Twenty-sixth Avenue; Twenty-seventh Avenue; Twenty-second Street; Twenty-third Street; Twenty-fifth Street; and Twenty-sixth Street; Twenty-seventh Street; Twenty-eighth Street; Twentyninth Street; Thirtieth Street; Thirty-first Street; Cottage Street; DeChillis Street; Burgess Street; Front Street; Anna Street; and Fern Avenue.

Section 2: The cost of said paving and curbing shall be born and assessed as follows:- The Township will bear fifty (50%) per cent of the construction costs and all the costs of any intersections, and the property owners on each side of the street improved under this Ordinance shall be assessed one-fourth (1/4) of the total cost of said construction.

Section 3: Any assessment authorized under this Ordinance shall be paid in full within thirty (30) days after

notice of such assessment shall have been given to the parties assessed as provided in the Second Class Township Code.

Section 4: If any assessment authorized under this Ordinance shall not have been paid in full within thirty (30) days after notice of such assessment shall have been given to the party assessed, it shall be the duty of the Township Solicitor to collect the same, with interest from the thirty (30) days after the completion of the improvement, by action of assumpsit or by lien to be filed and collected in the same manner as municipal claims.
