

ORDINANCE NO. 56

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WHITE,
BEAVER COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA,
VACATING 27TH STREET FROM 22ND AVENUE TO 21ST AVENUE

WHEREAS, all of the owners of property abutting on 27th Street between 22nd Avenue and 21st Avenue in the Township of White, Beaver County, Pennsylvania, have presented to the Board of Township Supervisors a Petition requesting the adoption of an Ordinance vacating said section of 27th Street, and

WHEREAS, said Petition was favorably received by the Board of Township Supervisors and it appearing that it is in the best interest of the public that said portion of 27th Street be vacated.

NOW, THEREFORE, be it enacted and ordained by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of White, a Township of the Second Class in the County of Beaver, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by said Board as follows:

SECTION 1: That 27th Street from 22nd Avenue to 21st Avenue, being more particularly bounded and described as follows:

ALL that certain parcel of land situate in the Township of White, County of Beaver and Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, being all that portion of Twenty-seventh Street in the Dawson Heights Plan of Lots lying between Twenty-first Avenue and Twenty-second Avenue, particularly bounded and described as follows, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a point formed by the intersection of the Western line of Twenty-first Avenue and the Southern line of Twenty-seventh Street; thence along the Southern line of Twenty-seventh Street South Eighty-one (81) Degrees Thirty (30) Minutes West, Two Hundred Fifteen and Seventy Hundredths (215.70) Feet to a point on the Northern line of Dawson Street; thence along the Northern line of Dawson Street North Seventy (70) Degrees Ten (10) Minutes Twenty (20) Seconds West, Eighty-four and Thirty Hundredths (84.30) Feet to the Northern line of Twenty-seventh Street; thence along the Northern line of Twenty-seventh Street North Eighty-one (81) Degrees Thirty (30) Minutes East, Two Hundred Ninety (290) Feet, more or less, to the Western line of Twenty-first Avenue; thence along the Western line of Twenty-first Avenue South Eight (8) Degrees Thirty (30) Minutes East, Forty (40) Feet to a point the place of beginning,

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is hereby vacated.

SECTION 2: The Petitioners named in the aforesaid Petition shall pay the costs and expenses of the publication of this Ordinance and all other costs incident to this vacation.

SECTION 3: A copy of this Ordinance, together with a draft or survey of the vacated street showing the location and width thereof shall be filed in the Office of the Clerk of Quarter Sessions Division of the Court of Common Pleas of the County of Beaver in accordance with the provisions of the Second Class Township Code.

SECTION 4: All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance shall be and the same are hereby repealed.
