### ❖ Correspondence:

1. Chief submitted a letter stating Patterson Township Police contract is set to expire December 2022.
2. J. Young Refuse garbage contract extension thru 2024

### ❖ Unfinished Business:

1. **2022 Sanitary Sewer Improvements Project:** Project is being funded in part by the County ARPA amount of \$151,000. Project started on 6/20/22.  
***Make a motion to approve partial payment No. 1 for this project in the amount of \$84,151.00***
2. **Beaver Falls Sewer System CAP:** Emily Palmer mentioned she would like the supervisors to focus on 3 topics to be discussed at a future meeting. Dye testing, smoke testing, and physical manhole cover surveys. They'll need to decide what/if we can do any of these in house or if they need to go out to bid. She's estimating it would be around \$150,000.00 if sent out to bid. She would like the completion date of these items to be done by 12/31/2022.
  - Service Order Authorization, Beaver Falls Corrective Action Plan-from LSSE- Supervisor to discuss further during a workshop meeting.
3. **CFA Multimodal Grant (Mt. Washington Rds.):** Resolution 6 of 2022 needs approved during July meeting,  
***Make a motion to approve resolution 6 of 2022***  
Applications are due by 7/31/22. Jim Marshall will send a support letter.
4. **Multimodal Grant-12<sup>th</sup> Ave. Bridge Project (PennDOT):** Grant was awarded in the amount of \$400,600.00 with a 30% local share match required. Field surveys are complete. Base map drawings are being prepared to proceed. Engineers are working with PennDOT on the next steps.
5. **CFA 2022 Local Share Account (LSA) Statewide:** Waiting for approval or denial for the following grants that LSSE has applied for on behalf of the Township:
  - **Sanitary Sewer System Rehabilitation- \$560,430.00**
  - **Road Improvement Program- \$868,584.00**
6. Get pricing to replace manhole covers for our existing size instead of replacing the entire casting. - Craighead & Anna manhole cover-*Supervisor Evans, Jr. said he's still trying to find a company that can make our same size lids so we don't have to change the entire hole size. He has 2 more companies in mind to call.*
7. Front street, 29<sup>th</sup> St. & 22<sup>nd</sup> Ave. storm drain-both locations had a PA One Call done in early June.
8. Look into pricing for cameras/security systems at both the Township Building and Garage.  
*Supervisor Evans, Jr. said he's having trouble getting any companies to call him back. He finally spoke to Guardian Protection minutes before the meeting and they agreed to draw up a quote that we will look at for the next meeting.*
