

WHITE TOWNSHIP MEETING OF THE SUPERVISORS October 5, 2022

On Wednesday, October 5, 2022 in the Meeting Room of the Township Building, located at 2511 13th Ave. in White Township, PA 15010, the Regular Monthly Meeting was called to order at approximately 7:00PM by Supervisor Evans Jr. This meeting was advertised in the *Beaver County Times* on January 18, 2022 in accordance with the Sunshine Law, Section 709.

Public Forum:

1. Ray Dusch-2305 12th Ave.: Mr. Dusch brought up the gravel that was dumped on the side of his property and why such big rocks were used and can we fix it. It was determined that the previous road crew foreman did that without supervisor approval. Per Solicitor Bible we now have to make it right by leveling the gravel out and adding proper limestone on top so it's usable for the homeowners. Mr. Dusch also brought up that J. Young Refuse did not pick up garbage in Mt. Washington for 2 weeks now claiming they couldn't get up the hill because of construction on Steffin Hill. -Secretary Dean said she would call them first thing in the morning and get that taken care of. They do have access to get into Mt. Washington even with construction.
2. Bill Townsend-1007 Steffin Hill Rd.: Mr. Townsend was here to purchase 3 properties in Mt. Washington off of the county repository list and needed the supervisors to sign off on the purchase/waiving back taxes. – Supervisor Evans, Jr. signed off.

Reports:

- Earned Income Tax: \$10,000.23

- Road Crew: Dan is to call Stephenson and get quotes for backhoe and skid steerer parts and to see if skid steerer is under warranty still. Dan was also told to work on the backhoe pins by greasing them and hammering them out. He is to measure the shocks for the backhoe window and get those to Supervisor Evans, Jr. so we can order new ones.

Unfinished Business:

1. **Beaver Falls Sewer System CAP:** Supervisors to focus on 3 topics to be discussed at a future meeting. Dye testing, smoke testing, and physical manhole cover surveys. They'll need to decide what/if we can do

any of these in house or if they need to go out to bid. Estimating it would be around \$150,000.00 if sent out to bid. Must be complete by 12/31/2022.

2. **CFA Multimodal Grant (Mt. Washington Rds.):** Waiting for approval or denial in the amount of \$442,407.00.
3. **Multimodal Grant-12th Ave. Bridge Project (PennDOT):** Grant was awarded in the amount of \$400,600.00 with a 30% local share match required. Engineers are working with PennDOT on the next steps.
4. **CFA 2022 Local Share Account (LSA) Statewide:** Waiting for approval or denial for the following grants that LSSE has applied for on behalf of the Township:
 - Sanitary Sewer System Rehabilitation- \$560,430.00 & Road Improvement Program- \$868,584.00
