1 Multimodal and LSA Denial to be discussed under unfinished business

Solicitor sent letter to Strohecker say to make repairs to garage and 2 right to know letters

❖ Unfinished Business:

1. Sewer Repair ARPA Funding: After completion of the Old Steffin Hill project, there is \$69,740.50 plus \$13,948.10 20% copay remaining from the ARPA Grant awarded by the County for sewer repairs. New projects are being designed for the use of the remaining funds to be presented at Mays meeting. Funds must be expended by Dec 2024

Looked over 3 sections of sewers with the engineers to repair with funds, just over 1,000ft of sewer to reline. Jarrad recommended a motion for LSSE to prepare the engineering and advertisements for May's meeting

2. Beaver Falls Sewer System CAP: Supervisors to focus on 3 topics to be discussed at a future meeting. Dye testing, smoke testing, and physical manhole cover surveys.

Nothing new on LSSE's end

Evans Jr has run camera through lines made accessible on Mt. Washington and located next manhole locations to be made accessible. He also ran camera through sewer lines in 12TH Ave to inspect their condition prior to moving forward with projects on 12TH Ave.

3. CFA Multimodal Grant (Mt. Washington Rds.): Received a denial in the amount of \$442,407.00.

4. **Multimodal Grant-12th Ave. Bridge Project (PennDOT):** Grant was awarded in the amount of \$400,600.00 with a 30% local share match required. Engineers are working with PennDOT on the next steps.

LSSE Submitted permits for culvert crossing and designs to Penn DOT

Adjoining may be needed and is being claimed to be a pet cemetery, no proof has been found LSSE is still working on it.

5. **CFA 2022 Local Share Account (LSA) Statewide:** Received a denial for the following grants that LSSE has applied for on behalf of the Township:

- Sanitary Sewer System Rehabilitation- \$560,430.00 & Road Improvement Program- \$868,584.00

6. **Small Water & Sewer Grant:** Waiting for approval or denial in the amount of \$425,000 for 22nd Ave. and Craighead Lane projects. Also, in the amount of \$89,600.00 for Sewer System Cleaning and Televising.

Mid July tentative for awards meeting

❖ New Business:

1. **Disproportionate Impact Funds:** Funds can be used to replace sanitary or storm sewers and repave as restoration of project. Several projects are being looked at and the ability to maximize the funds. The funds may also be used in demolition of blighted properties, this is also being explored. Funds must be expended by Dec 2024

Supervisor Evans Jr attended a meeting on 3-30-23 at the Beaver Co Court house with County executives and their representees in regards to the disproportionate impact funds. The Twp received Apx \$442,000. The Twp is allowed to use for sewer and storm drain replacement projects and subsequent street restoration. Projects are being looked at first to be brought to at may's meeting. County will allow Twp to install and pay for materials and pay paving/street restoration.

The county also will allow for demolition of blighted properties from these funds
