March 1, 2023

2. Salt Bid- A bid of 100 ton will be placed for 2023-2024 Costars, currently the Twp has 75-100 ton on site and has taken no deliveries from the current salt contract of 300 tons and must take delivery of the 180 ton minimum

3. Small waters grant- Letter received requesting more information on application, this was prepared by LSSE and is being sent

Unfinished Business:

1. Sewer Repair ARPA Funding: After completion of the Old Steffin Hill project, there is \$69,740.50 remaining from the ARPA Grant awarded by the County for sewer repairs.
2. Beaver Falls Sewer System CAP: Supervisors to focus on 3 topics to be discussed at a future meeting. Dye testing, smoke testing, and physical manhole cover surveys. They'll need to decide what/if we can do any of these in house or if they need to go out to bid. Estimating it would be around \$150,000.00 if sent out to bid. Must be complete by 1/31/23.
3. CFA Multimodal Grant (Mt. Washington Rds.): Waiting for approval or denial in the amount of \$442,407.00. Awards are scheduled for 3-17-2023
4. Multimodal Grant-12th Ave. Bridge Project (PennDOT): Grant was awarded in the amount of \$400,600.00 with a 30% local share match required. Engineers are working with PennDOT on the next steps. Look at using a aluminized structure instead of a box culvert to lower cost and stream line permitting Penn Dot considers such structures as having a 100 year life span
5. CFA 2022 Local Share Account (LSA) Statewide: Waiting for approval or denial for the following grants that LSSE has applied for on behalf of the Township: Awards are scheduled for 3-17-2023
 - Sanitary Sewer System Rehabilitation- \$560,430.00 & Road Improvement Program- \$868,584.00
6. Small Water & Sewer Grant: Waiting for approval or denial in the amount of \$425,000 for 22nd Ave. and Craighead Lane projects. Also, in the amount of \$89,600.00 for Sewer System Cleaning and Televising. This Grant will be a late summer decision.

New Business:

Soliciting bids for roof on office and Garage, prices both metal and asphalt. Larry recommended specifying standing seam if metal

Resurfacing McCready Ave with new 2A limestone and doing grading to gutter line as soon as weather permits
