### ❖ Unfinished Business:

1. Sewer Repair ARPA Funding: Lines have been cleaned and CCTV, installation of 2 eight inch lines starts 9-7 six inch line to be discussed.  
1<sup>st</sup> pay request received for project **Motin to approve**
2. Beaver Falls Sewer System CAP: The last few areas for camera work are also being made accessible with the improving weather and smoke testing will be starting back up

No Changes on LSSE's end Twp is adding 21<sup>st</sup> Ave 30<sup>th</sup> St to 31<sup>st</sup> St to the camera and smoke testing due to sings of high infiltration found on inspection for lining from 21<sup>st</sup> Ave to 19<sup>th</sup> Ave

3. Multimodal Grant-12<sup>th</sup> Ave. Bridge Project (PennDOT): Grant was awarded in the amount of \$400,600.00 with a 30% local share match required. Engineers are working with PennDOT

LSSE Received comments from Penn Dot, and resubmitted documents

4. Small Water & Sewer Grant: Waiting for approval or denial in the amount of \$425,000 for 22<sup>nd</sup> Ave. and Craighead Lane projects. Also, in the amount of \$89,600.00 for Sewer System Cleaning and Televising. Approval/denial pushed back until September tentative

September 19<sup>th</sup> is the tentative date for awards

5. Disproportionate Impact Funds: Funds can be used to replace sanitary or storm sewers and repave as restoration of project. Several projects are being looked at, the first projects are.

- 12<sup>th</sup> Ave from the bridge project to the Beaver Falls line including a portion of 23<sup>rd</sup> St

Storm Drains are expected to be starting on Monday the 11<sup>th</sup> pending no farther issues with the one-call  
The current one-call was discussed with Solicitor Bible as we have made multiple one-calls but have not got a response from BFFMA, this has been an ongoing issue affecting several projects. Solicitor Bible suggested calling BFFMA directly to see if we can get it moved forward.

The funds may also be used in demolition of blighted properties, approximately 7 properties have currently been identified.

Progress on purchasing 9 properties Solicitor

Solicitor Bible is preparing a letter to Beaver County for purchase of properties

6. Autistic Child signage was discussed for 13<sup>th</sup> Ave, currently Penn Dot does not have a standard for such signage. It was discussed to go based off of the signage standards for Deaf/Blind signage. Solicitor Bible will draft an ordnances for the signs.
